To: Potential Recruit Candidates

Sir,

I want to take a moment of your time to introduce you to the Ammon Fire Department.

Our department is a combination department consisting of 40 paid-call firefighters (also called compensated volunteers) and three full-time firefighters. We hire for the paid-call positions one time each year. There are three requirements you must meet to be considered for employment:

- You must be at least 18 years of age;
- You must possess a valid driver's license;
- You must live within ten minutes of the Ammon Fire Station. (2137 S Ammon Rd)

All applicants must pass the following to be considered for an interview:

- Criminal history/background check;
- Written acceptance test;
- Physical agility test, this test is outlined on the attached document.

All new recruits are required to complete IFSAC FF I Certification, Hazardous Materials Awareness and Wildland Fire Certification in their first year. IFSAC accreditation training lasts for approximately six months; classes are every Tuesday and Thursday from 1800-2200 hours and two Saturdays per month from 0800-1700 hours. All chapter tests must be completed by set deadlines, if a recruit misses a class we require them to schedule make-up dates to keep them current. Any recruit missing more than half of the scheduled classes will be dismissed from the department.

We pay recruits \$100.00 per month for training; once a firefighter is trained to a minimum level they receive a pager and are compensated for each call they respond too in addition to their training pay. All firefighters are required to attend a minimum of 75% of all regular scheduled training to be eligible for monthly pay.

If you are interested in a paid-call position with our department, please fill out the application packet and return it to the Ammon City Office by the closing date.
