It is the responsibility of each Parks & Recreation Commission / Committee member to provide feedback and direction to the Mayor, City Council, and Parks & Recreation Director on a wide array of park and recreational issues.

### **Are you ready to become more involved with Parks & Recreation?**

#### **Things to consider before applying:**

- Members of these groups serve on a voluntary basis and receive no financial compensation.
- Participation requires a significant time commitment (approx. 10-15 hrs. /month).
- Due to a limited number of members in a committee, a vacancy must exist in order for a new applicant to be considered.
- When all applications have been received, the Mayor makes an appointment to be confirmed by the Ammon City Council.

#### **Applicants must:**

Fulfill the residency requirements stated in the Call for Application.

Not be an employee of the City of Ammon.

Not serve on more than one (1) City board, commission, or committee at the same time.

#### **How to apply:**

To apply for a vacant position, please submit the following items to the Ammon City Hall, attention Ken Knoch, Parks & Recreation Director by 5:00 p.m. on March 19, 2010 the date of closing. (2135 Ammon Rd., Ammon, Idaho, 83406).

- Complete and sign the application form.
- Letter of interest sent to Ken Knoch, Parks & Recreation Director.
- Up-to-date resume listing education and relevant work and volunteer experience.
